Q: I have keys but no doors. I have space but no rooms, I allow you to enter but you are never able to leave. What am I?

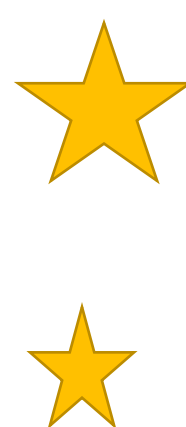
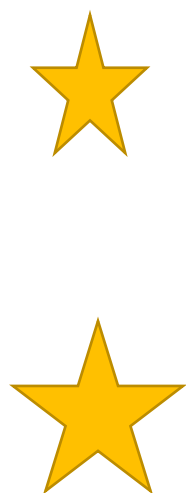
A: *A keyboard!*
