NAPLAN – Mon 13th May to Fri 17th May

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is an annual national assessment for all students in years 3, 5, 7 and 9. Urbenville students participating in NAPLAN this year have been working diligently in class in preparation for testing in week 3 this term. NAPLAN tests are constructed to give students an opportunity to demonstrate skills they have learned over time through the school curriculum. The best way you can help your child prepare for NAPLAN is to reassure them that NAPLAN tests are just one part of their school program, and urge them to simply do the best they can do on the day. If you have any questions about your child's preparation for NAPLAN, you are encouraged to make a time to speak with their teacher.

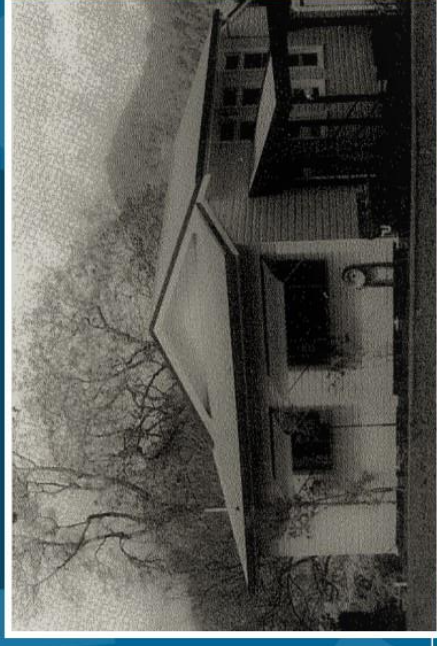
